

# REGULATION

## Karawanken Classic-Cup 2026

### 1. PERMITTED EVENTS

Historic events for motor vehicles that meet the below mentioned requirements are accepted for KCC.

KCC includes regularity rallies in accordance with regulations of the Austria Motorsport Federation (AMF) / FIVA.

The average speed of 50 km/h must not be exceeded. In principle, the task (especially timing and regularity stages) should be selected in that way that they can be maintained for the prescribed categories of vehicles in compliance with the STVO-regulations and taking into account obstruction of traffic (e.g. railroad crossings).

#### Evaluation accepted:

- Stages and special stages with prescribed times or average speeds.
- Regularity stages (e.g. slalom, reversing)
- Passage controls and secret controls

#### Evaluation not accepted:

- Joke evaluations (absolutely prohibited)
- Evaluations aiming on maximum speed (absolutely prohibited)
- Touristic questions

The technical and sporty responsibility lies with the individual organizers.

### 2. PARTICIPATION

Only cars are allowed to participate in the KCC 2026.

Participation is open to all nationals and foreigners, who have reached the age of 18 and are in possession of a valid driving license. A team basically consists of a driver and a navigator. An exchange between driver and navigator is allowed.

Participation with trial or transfer plates or plates registered abroad is permitted in accordance with government regulations.

Eligible to participate in "KCC 2026" are all drivers who participates in at least in one of the events of the KCC 2026. Registrations or entries for the individual events can be accepted according to the conditions of the respective organizer.

### 3. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

Eligible are historic automobiles up to and including the year 2005 (by the date of first registration acc. type certificate).

Trucks or military vehicles are not eligible to start.

For the KCC, only an overall ranking of all individual classes is taken into account.

### 4. PARTICIPATING EVENTS

The following events will take part in 2023:

### 5. SCORING, EVALUATION

- The organizer has to evaluate an overall standing for KCC participants and to submit it to the leading organizer of the KCC.
- Separate evaluation for driver and navigators.
- Exchange of vehicle or class between the individual events is permitted.
- No class classification for KCC 2026. But the organizers are free to subdivided classes, to merge classes or to create special classes..
- In addition, 3 points are awarded for each start and finish.
- Foreign participants receive 5 bonus points per event:  
e.g., Croatian participants at events in Austria,  
or Austrian participants at events in Croatia.  
However, the maximum for foreign participations will be 15 points for each driver/co-pilot.

#### Points achieved are added as follows:

- Points for overall ranking
- Start and finish points (3 points each)
- For foreign participants: 5 points per foreign start (max. 15 points total)

The amount of points will be multiplied by the factor of the respective event. This factor depends on the number of special stages and the valence of the event and is determined by the organizers.

**Factors of the events:**

• Classic-Shorttrack	Veranstaltungs-Faktor	2
• Croatia-ClassicMarathon	Veranstaltungs-Faktor	3
• SMS-Classic-Sprint	Veranstaltungs-Faktor	1
• Adriatic Tour	Veranstaltungs-Faktor	3
• Burgen & Schlösser-Classic	Veranstaltungs-Faktor	3

In case of a equal points, the points achieved with the older vehicle are considered more valuable.

**6. TOOLS**

**The following supports are generally prohibited:**

- Electronic regularity calculators with connection to the odometer
- GPS navigation devices or even mobile phones with GPS navigation
- Laptops

**8. CUPS AND TROPHIES**

There is a separate ranking for drivers and co-pilots.

The first 15 drivers / navigators will receive prizes:

- Ranking 1 to 10 for drivers
- Ranking 1 to 10 for navigators
